

HORIZON CENTRAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

(IN MEMORY OF KENT LESSMEISTER)

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded annually. Preference will be for one male and one female but not exclusive.

A. The applicant must have graduated from a Horizon School Division school and competed in Horizon athletics during his/her grade eleven and grade twelve years.

B. The student must have an average of at least 70% in subject areas required for minimum entrance requirements for his/her intended area of study.

C. The recipient should exhibit strong leadership and sportsmanship qualities as well as being a positive role model in his/her school and/or community.

D. The recipient must be enrolled in first year studies in one of the following programs in a Saskatchewan Post Secondary Institution:

- College of Kinesiology (U of S)
- Faculty of Education with a major or minor in Physical Education (U of R)
- Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies (U of R)
- Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology (SIAST) in a leisure and recreation program.

E. This scholarship is only eligible to students following his/her first year after graduation.

In order for the nomination to be accepted the following documentation must be submitted:

1. A letter of nomination from a teacher/coach which highlights the qualities and achievements of the nominee.
2. A resume from the student outlining his/her contribution to Horizon Athletics and include his/her athletic accomplishments within the community.
3. A personal statement from the student about his/her philosophy of physical education (no longer than 250 words)
4. A transcript of the student's marks.

F. A Confirmation of Enrolment will suffice in the release of the scholarship fund.

G. Applications will be accepted by "The President" of HCAA prior to June 1st.
